CIAL to host air show

The air show, which has been designed as a static one, will have a minimum of 10 business aircraft and a few helicopters from major manufacturers like Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd, BELL and Euro Copter

KERALITES will have the rare chance of witnessing an air show in the Kochi International Airport premises here by the end of April as the CIAL signed an MoU with Titan Aviation, a Dubai-based Aviation company on Monday. The Titan Aviation will act as co-partner with CIAL in conducting and bringing aircrafts for the show.

The MoU has been signed by Kochi Airport Director ACK Nair and Sajad Mohamed, CEO of Titan Aviation. The air show will help to improve the brand visibility of CIAL. To give the public a close-up view of modern executive jets and helicopters and to create awareness among the public are the main aims of the show in CIAL, managing director C G Krishnan Nair said.

The air show which has designed as a static one, will have a minimum of ten business aircrafts and few helicopters from major manufac-

turers like Hindustan Aeronautics Ltd., BELL and Euro Copter. The static display will be opened to the business visitors, VVIP/VIPs, high net worth individuals, MNCs and dignitaries from tourism companies, government departments, the public and students especially from the Aviation Institutes like Flight School, AME Colleges, Simulator Sessions, Flight Stewards Training Schools, IATA Institutes and Ground Crew Training Schools in the State. The three-day air show, scheduled to begin on April 28 will be managed by a team com-

prising CIAL officials, CIASL and Titan Aviation.

On the opening day the static display of aircrafts & helicopters at CIAL Apron will be held. The display will be opened to VVIPs, HNVC Customers, MNCs and dignitaries on an invitation basis. On the second day the show will be opened to tourism companies, resorts owners, representatives, hospitals etc. The display will be shifted to the CIASL-MRO area and opened to general public and students on the concluding day on April 30.

Aircrafts like Phenom 100 - Light Business Jet, King Air C 90 B - Turbo prop, Euro copter - Turbine Helicopter, Bell 407 - Turbine Helicopter, Cessna 172 -Piston Engine, Lear 60 X R - Private Jet, Micro light /Ultralight and Embraer will be displayed in the airshow. Probably this is the first time that an airport in the state is organising such an air show.
